

Come aboard – jump on your bike!

We invite you to join our tour on the Baltic Sea leading along the Swedish coast towards Greifswald in Germany to demand an effective energy transition worldwide, now!

We will cruise the Baltic Sea, share experiences in activism from different countries, start a transnational network, try out creative forms of protest and get active on the streets.

We want to form a group of active people from different countries like Denmark, Finland, Sweden, Norway, Poland, Russia and also France to state a joint message for a renewable future without nuclear power!

We are working together with organisations and activists from Poland and Sweden and are still looking for more groups and people to be part of the sail- and bicycle-tour and plan some actions with us.

For two weeks we will live on the "Lovis" - a large traditional sailing ship with an interesting history, which offers a nice atmosphere and follows its mission of bringing people together and giving them room for a joint experience of exchange, sharing and learning (www.lovis.de). We will be on board of the "Lovis" on the last stage of its tour along the Baltic Sea coast and bring our joint message to all the harbours and stops that we will pass on our trip.

A second group will be on their bikes and be active along the shoreline. There will be regular contact between the bikers and the sailors and there will be meetings in some places to do actions together. The route we have planned so far:

Stockholm - Nyköping - Oskarshamn - Kalmar - Karloskrona - Rügen - Lubmin - Greifswald.

Of course there will be more stops in between. We plan to have some more time for action in Stockholm, Oskarshamn, Lubmin.

Our common principles during the trip will be based on honest and fair communication. We won't accept any discriminating behaviour based on fascism, racism and sexism, homophobia and other forms of discrimination.

We want to make sure that all have a good time. We will plan and carry out activities on the base of consensus decision making. Food will be vegetarian and vegan.

We are asking you to travel to Stockholm and from Greifswald using public transport, except planes.
